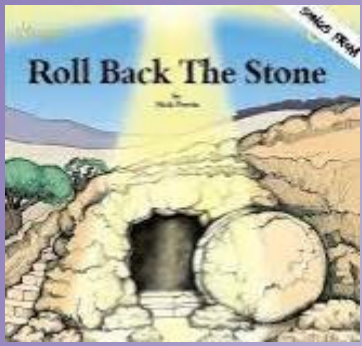
Well done to the children who performed in the Rocksteady concerts. You all played and sang wonderfully!

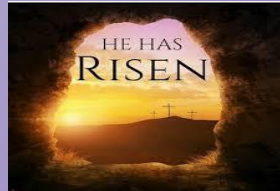
