 This was when the angel Gabriel went to Mary and told her that she will have a son by the power of the Holy Spirit and that she must name him Jesus.




#### The Visitation

 This was when Jesus was born. This is now known as Christmas.




#### The Presentation

 Jesus was Babtised in the River Jordan by John the Babtist.




## The Wedding at Cana

 Jesus performed his first miracle which was turning water into wine.




## The Proclamation Of the Kingdom

 Jesus reveals the cause of our illness.




## The Transfiguration

 This was when Jesus is transfigurated and became in glory upon a mountain.




#### The Institution of the Eucharist

 This was the Last Supper.




The Agony in the Garden


## The Scourging at the Pillar

 A crown of thorns was placed on the head of Jesus during the events leading up to the crucifixion.




# The Carrying of the Cross

There are 14 stationsthat describe exactly what happened.




### The Crucifiction

• This was when Jesus rose from the dead.




#### The Ascention
