Subject	Focus	ACTIVITIES
R.E	To recall the period of Lent and focus on the suffering of Jesus.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Remember the events of Good Friday and Easter Sunday.2. Use a Bible if you have one to read the events - use Matthew, Mark, Luke or John, compare the differences between them.3. Look at the pdf about Holy week.4. Write 2 diary entries, one about Good Friday and one about Easter Sunday. You should pretend to be a disciple - include what it would have been like to experience these events. What was said? What do you (as a disciple) think about what happened?5. OPTIONAL - stations of the cross video to share at home. https://bustedhalo.com/video/virtual-stations-of-the-cross
SCIENCE	To understand what micro-organisms are. To investigate micro-organisms.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Check the answers to animal grouping from last week.2. Read the pdf about micro-organisms.3. Group the helpful and harmful micro-organisms into 3 groups - fungi, bacteria, virus. On a word document, explain what micro-organisms are and how they are grouped. List the micro-organisms in their groups.4. Set up the mould experiment - 2 smaller pieces of bread will do, you don't need to waste 2 slices! There is a challenge 1 and 3 to choose from. Use the pdf as a guide. Write up your experiment using the guide.5. There are 2 optional activities to consolidate last week's learning if you want to do them.
HISTORY	To realise the impact of rationing.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Explore the pdf documents about rationing - think about what it was like during WWII. Complete either 2 or 3.2. Create a poster about rationing (use ideas from the pdf) this could be completed on a computer and sent as a pdf or you could do it on paper and send a photograph of your work.3. Create a recipe that would have been possible during war time (use ideas from pdf). You could even make the meal, although this not compulsory!
ART	Easter Card	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Create an Easter card for somebody, perhaps you could send it in the post to someone you haven't seen for a while. Try and send a picture of your card by email.
