March 15 AD

Dear Diary,

Today I awoke early as I had so many butterflies in my stomach it was impossible to sleep. I was so excited as today was the day that I would finally swear my oath of allegiance and join the Roman Army! Can you believe that I Servius Felix, the son of a poor farmer, was about to become the first in our family to become a Legionary?

By the time it was my turn to swear my oath of allegiance, I was so nervous that my hands had become clammy. In all honesty (because of my nerves) I cannot remember much about the event.

After this I was given my viaticum, I held the three shining gold coins in my palm and decided that I was going to save these for my future. That's when my thoughts turned to my retirement what would I choose: the 3 acres of land or the 3000 Roman denarii?

Later I was shown where I would be sleeping. In the tent were eight narrow beds, that didn't look particularly comfortable. I was told that my bed was the one on the far left.

I have just been told that my legion and three others will undertake a great march of 30,000 roman paces at dawn tomorrow. This is not what I imagined being a legionary would be like, I thought I would have people bowing before me and we would be fighting great battles against the enemy. Instead, I have had to cook my own dinner, sleep in a hard bed beside another soldier (who snores so loud that the tent poles shake!) and tomorrow I will march in full armour to Londinium. I have only been here for 8 hours and I already miss home and my family.
