

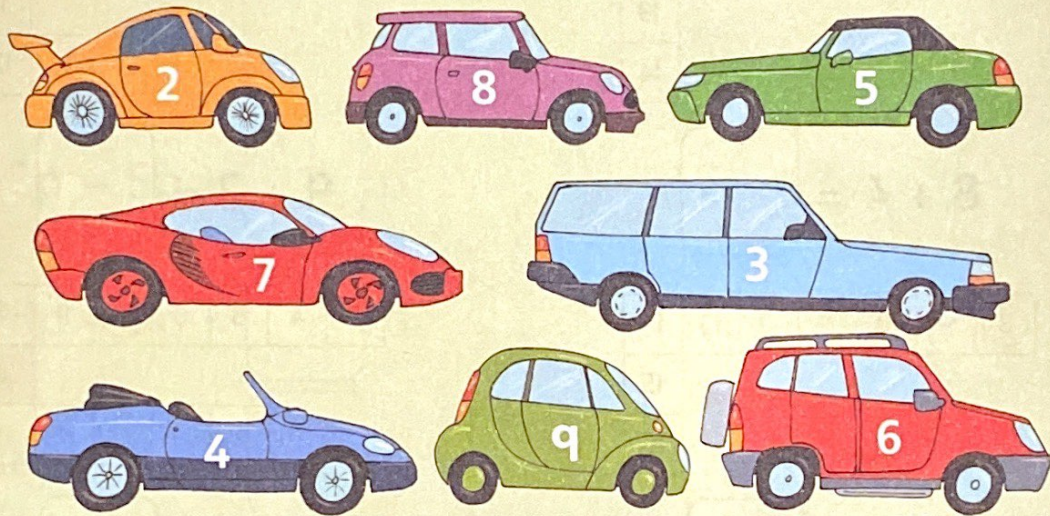
Additions totalling more than 10

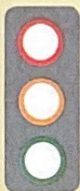
