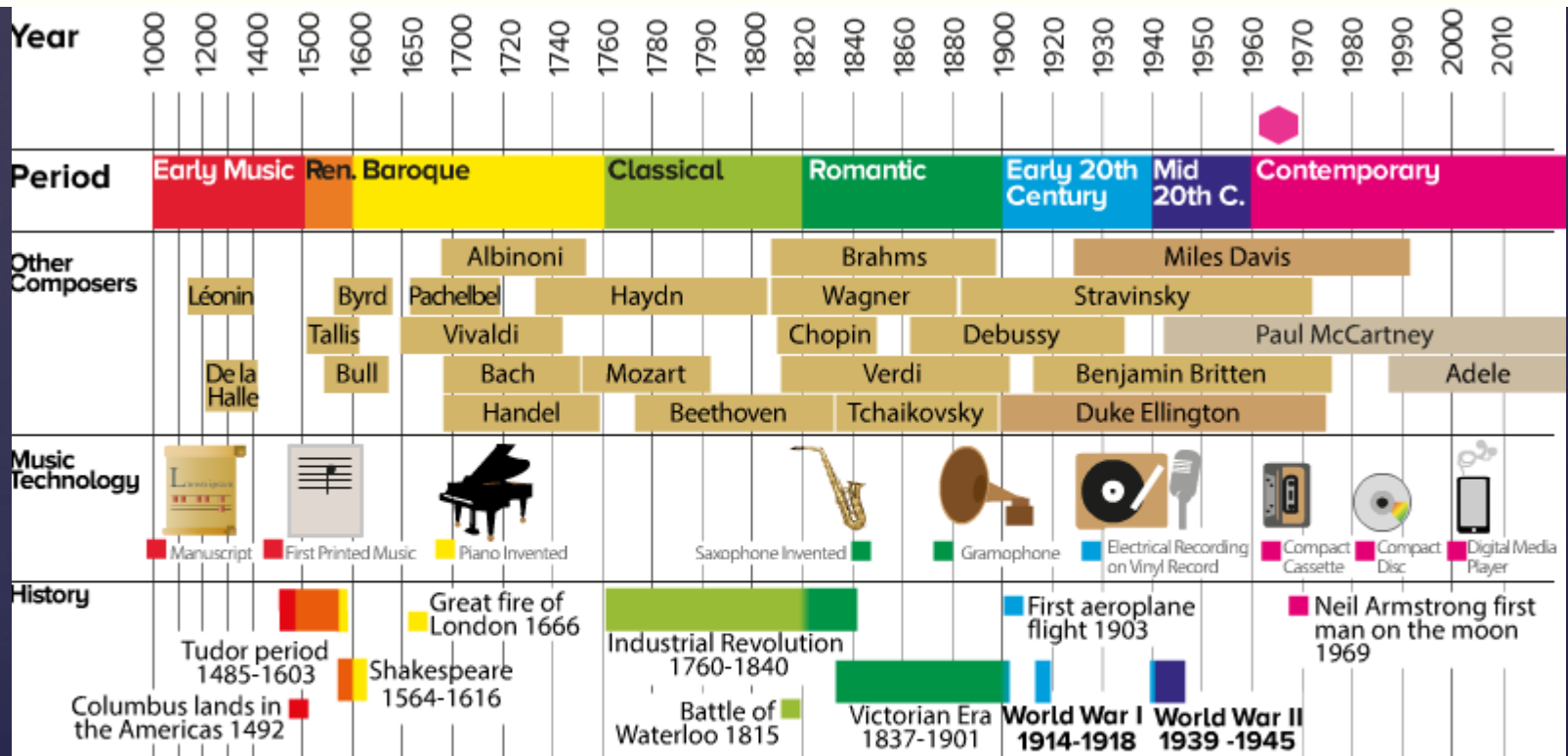

I Can't Help Myself (Sugar Pie Honey Bunch) written by Brian Holland, Lamont Dozier, and Edward Holland Jr in 1965 and recorded by the Four Tops for the Motown label. The song is one of the most well-known Motown tunes of the 1960s. I Can't Help Myself is known as one of the greatest songs of all time and has been covered extensively since 1965.
