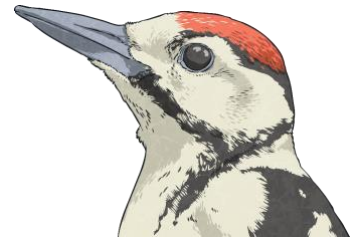


Similes



Similes are figures of speech where one thing is compared to another thing. To compare, the word 'like' or the phrases 'as as a ' are used.
