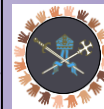

### CAFOD - The Big Lent Walk



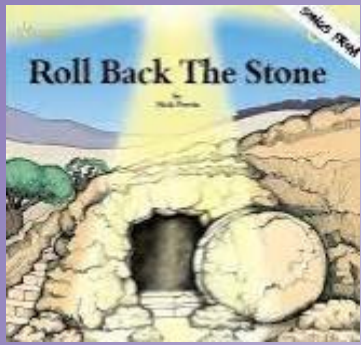
