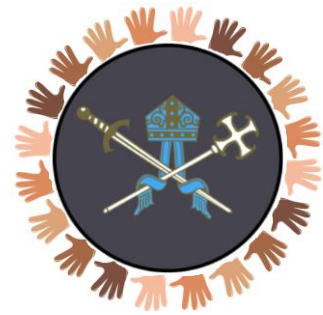






# Cultural Diversity Day

*Creating artwork to represent other cultures and countries*

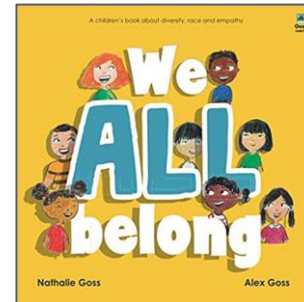


*Exploring customs and cultures*
